

Maintaining A Full Hebraic Walk In Your BYSW Assembly Based on the Ten Commandments-Eser Hadvarim-10 words

- Seeing YHWH-Yahshua as ONE Whole Wheat Unleavened Bread **Shemot 20:1-5**. If we see a trinity or twinity, we do not see the truth and place other elohim before YHWH's face. **Our BYSW assemblies must be focused on the truth of the whole wheat unleavened bread.**
- **Guard all the doable and applicable commands.** Torah must be the basis of all our guidelines **Shemot/Exodus 20:6**.
- **Usage of the true Name** within and without our gates and in our homes and synagogues. For far too long false titles in place of YHWH have been used as YHWH is looking for a redeemed faithful remnant that uses, proclaims and restores His name, even when others come against us for diverse reasons **Shemot 20:7, Shemot 3:14-15**.
- **Shabbat the 7th day is the key and door opener** (Yeshayahu 58:13-14) **to a Hebraic lifestyle and return Shemot 20:8-11**.
- We must honor our physical parents, but also our spiritual parents. Every BYSW assembly should teach their sheep to honor and respect their spiritual parents, so that our days on earth and in ministry can be lengthened and so that YHWH's people walk decently and in order. **Torah reminds us elsewhere that we should not curse a ruler, or shepherd of our people. Do not allow people in your congregation to curse you, or other leaders in YHWH's house.** Also you and I must have others we see as spiritual parents in the faith to keep a healthy balanced leadership **Shemot 20:12**.
- **A BYSW congregation maintains a Hebraic walk by not murdering one another and not allowing murder of one other by false accusation, innuendo, here say and other such demonic things brought about by others.** Yochanan Alef 1:8-11. 3:14-16.
- **Adultery is a sign of the pagans and hedonistic lifestyles.** Hebrews keep their passions in check and Hebraic assemblies teach sexual

restraint and satisfaction within the boundaries of a monogamous marriage relationship Kepha Alef 2:9-12. Demand and live in purity.

- **Yisrael shall not steal**-Shemot 20:15. Do we as leaders rob YHWH when we tell others not to? Do we steal, or encourage stealing by telling disciples that paying tithe is no longer necessary? Stealing can manifest in 2 forms. **From YHWH and from one another Mattiyahu 23:23**. Tithing is part of a program of Torah, both weightier and lesser matters.
- Our congregations must not allow, or receive any report that is not backed up by eye witness evidence of 3 credible witnesses Shemot 20:16. Key word is credible. In a Hebraic walk people are never convicted upon the mere accusation, but upon evidence. No evidence, no guilt. **A false witness is one of the worst crimes in a Hebraic assembly**. Remove and expose the false witness and protect the sheep.
- Coveting position and rulership is a sign and sin of the pagans. Yisraelites don't seek position, or title but the blessings of the opportunities to serve. **Do not covet position** in Yisrael. A man's gifts will make room for him, or her in YHWH's service Shemot/Exodus 20:17. **In a Yisraelite assembly give people opportunities to serve without title** Mattiyahu 20: 25-28.
