Romans 10:4 - KJV incorrectly translates the original Greek.

Messiah has brought the Torah, to an end according to this verse. For 2,000 yrs the de-judaizing of the faith, has systematically occurred. All vestiges of Jewish practice were purposely and diabolically removed, to "pay back" those Christ killers.

Question - Has the Torah come to an end? Is it no longer applicable to believing Jews. What About believing Gentiles? In Matthew 5:17-19 ^{to complete} Teshua teaches just the opposite. How can Teshua teach Torah observance, while Paul seems to teach against it? The answer can be found with a correct

~~Greek~~ Greek translation of Romans 10:4. "It should read as follows:

"For the goal of which the Torah aims is the Messiah, who offers righteousness to everyone who trusts." Not, Messiah ends the Torah. But is it's goal. (Teshua)

God has called all believers into a lifestyle that honors the eternal Torah. All believers will naturally observe Torah, as a result of a Spirit led life. (Matt 22:37-39). Jewish believers are to celebrate

Biblical feasts in Torah, not to obtain righteousness, but to preserve & maintain Jewish identity. The Jewish disciples were always commanded, to celebrate Torah observances as eternal ordinances. If a Jewish believer is prevented from this freedom, it is the church who has built a

reverse wall of partition. Gentiles are not obliged or commanded to, observe Biblical feasts, but are invited to do so. Eph 2:12-13.

^{Eph 2} v.15 - Does not teach that Messiah has abolished Torah ordinances, which, Teshua said were eternal. What his death, abolished were man made rabbinical ordinances designed specifically to prevent Gentiles from approaching God. Teshua's death did not abolish Torah. - Romans 7:2, Rom 7:14,

v.16 it still is good & applies to every believer.

Cor - The church has taught that the ~~Torah~~ ^{Torah} is outside the framework of Christianity. That the church is without it, because it has been, abolished, so it is no longer around. - Rom 3:21 - They teach that God has brought eternal salvation, without the Torah being around to bother us.

^{The} Truth is that Romans 3:21, should read, ~~is~~ "But now quite apart from the Torah, God's way of making people righteous, in His sight has been made clear.

Thus, the church is not without it, rather it has received forgiveness,
