Inheriting The Promises

All the promises of Torah & Brit Chadashah are available to all believers by Messiah. How then do we take a promise and receive it personally? Word says: Na Aseh Ve Neshma.

The Kirsh says: Neshama. Deut. 4:14. Doing & Hearing. A promise is personally received by acting upon it in obedience. Deut 4:30. Promises overcome tribulation by concrete obedient action. Deut 5:27. Deut 6:3. Exod. 19:8. James 1:22-24.

James 1:25. The blessing or promise is in the deed. The deed is the road to the promise. Matt 7:21-23. 7:24-27.

Without performing the deed the promises remain unclaimed.

⊗ Faith obtains or discovers the promise, Heb. 6:12, Heb 11:33

⊗ but obedience brings it to reality. 2 Pet. 1:4-8.

V. 4. Promises given, but us. calls us to obey by adding works of, diligence, virtue, knowledge, patience, goodness, righteousness, *V. 10 If You do the Word

then the promises of entry into the kingdom is yours. Reading, studying & talking the word

builds faith that discovers the promise. Only obedience brings it ~~to~~ reality. James 2:19-22. By obedience, reality comes.

Close - Promises also known as "patience of the saints."

These promises come by faith for discovery & obedience for inheriting reality. Lev 14:12. James 1:4. Promises (patience) are in the perfect work of Torah.

James 2:26 - Dead Faith = Dead Promises.

Torah Faith = Living Promises.
