A Closeup Look At Divine Gov't.

All actions and authority in Yahshua's Divine gov't are done by theocratic appointment. Divine gov't is called to rule or shepherd Yahshua's people for their spiritual growth and maturity. In a theocracy, there is no voting, there are no trials, no open court, no voting or opinion polls. Yahweh tells and instructs his undershepherds exactly what he wants done and how and when he wants it done.

Eph. 4:8-11, declare that the 5 fold officers are to diligently govern Yahshua's people and that divine theocracy is a gift to his people from on high. Titus 1:5 Paul Shaul appointed, not voted, Titus the Ephraimite to "set in order" and appoint elders. Divine gov't is done and enacted when Yahweh through His Ruch ^{1:10-13} reveals and chooses His servants, who must enact His will. Titus ^{1:10-13} tells us that theocracy is by construction \odot designed to stop unruly, vain, prideful behavior. Titus is given Yahshua's authority to rebuke.

The Word of Yahweh is His constitution. His five fold ministers are His gov't officials. The constitution the Davar Yahweh is designed to correct, rebuke and reprove those who are out of order in the camp. Failure of a 5 fold minister to enact correction & rebuke will ultimately result in chaos, division, cliques, false doctrine and a divided house. Ultimately, Yahshua will remove a five-fold leader who cannot or will not enforce divine gov't.
2 Tim 4:2 reprove & rebuke. An example of this heaven ordained authority is 2 Tim. 4:14-15.

Examples: 1 Samuel 8:5-22. The people of Israel rejected a theocracy. They felt that it was constricting. They rejected law & order overseen by Yahweh through Judges & prophets, trading in appointed representatives - (theocracy) for democracy. They felt that a

King approved of by the people, would serve them better than a divine appointee. Rejecting Yahweh's selection in favor of a nice guy from among the people, will result in confusion, disorder and ultimately defeat. Every appointment or order made by popular opinion or man's desire will end in opposition to Yahweh.

This rejection of theocracy winds up with Saul involved in witchcraft (rebellion) 1 Sam. 15-23 and then becoming a Satanist, in 1 Samuel 28. Rejection of theocracy and Yahshua's appointed leader and the support and backing of a different leader, is rebellion which according to scripture is witchcraft! Israel's rejection of of theocracy, led to scores of wicked man-made appointed rulers after the kingdom split in 921 BCE. That ultimately led to the global diaspora in 70 AD, when once more Israel wanted self rule and "democracy", instead of Yahshua who was sent to re-store theocracy in Israel. Man prefers any kind of gov't, including monarchy, to theocracy! They would rather be abused by their choice (monarch), than be shepherded lovingly but strictly by Torah Yahweh's choice!

*Close - The solution to rebellion against theocracy is separation & isolation of those practicing witchcraft! Grounding the rebellious! Read Num. 16:1-40. After the removal of Korah's renege group, the accusations against Moshe got worse, v. 41. In the end Yahweh removed all the rebellious who had joined & supported Korah totalling $14,700 + 250 + 3 = 14,953$ who didn't trust Moshe, as the divinely appointed leader of Israel!
