

Jer. 31:31-

A Newer Covenant

v.31-

The new covenant was promised to both houses, about 150 years after Israel was sent into exile. This shows 1) the 10 tribes still existed 2) they existed as a separate & distinct nation from Judah and 3) would be re-married by a new ketubah. 4) that this renewed covenant would be an end time event 5) this would not be a hand covenant based upon lip service but unlike the Mosaic covenant, this would be a covenant that would take their hearts, not hands.

v.32- We see that both houses came out of Egypt together and received ketubah. Thus both houses were married to their husband.

Both houses broke the covenant repeatedly from the Exodus to the days of Messiah.

v.33- First the covenant is cut with both houses, but the ongoing ^{heart} surgery and the re-introduction to Torah and the engrafting of a healthy respect for Torah will occur after those days of 2 house renewal! Hos 8:12, Hos 8:9-10, Hos 9

11:8-9. Because Yehovah could not give up & destroy Ephraim, he thus promised Torah instruction & renewal for discipleship after the initial cutting of Brit Chadashah. v.33- Torah will be renewed in the hearts of the House of Israel or the Co-Ami of Hosea 1:9.

As a result of Torah instruction, Co-Ami Israel becomes Israel again. Or becomes AMI! ~~Or~~ Torah strangers become Torah lovers, via new heart!

Ezekiel 36:22-29! ^{Jer 31:} v.34- All Israelites from both houses who wants to know Yehovah, can & will! The desire to know him will not be brotherly inspired but an inward conviction to know him personally. Speaks of the day when all Israelites will be priests, not just the greatest priests & prophets.

V.34 forgiveness to all from both houses will be granted & sin forgotten.

Notice all these promises are to Israelites from both houses. No Gentiles. No Nations. No Christians! Sorry!

Jer. 31:28 tells us that the Brit Chadashah is Yahweh's means by which to plant that which was plucked up! Jer. 33:6-8, & 14!

Heb. 8:6 tells us it is Yahweh who was appointed the mediator of this new covenant. Verse 8 tells us who these New Covenant believers are.

Close - Heb. 10:14 - Believers have been set-apart & perfected by the offering of Messiah for all time. V.15 - The Ruach is witnessing this forgiveness to them as he did through Jeremiah. Thus the Ruach Himself is a living witness that those set apart by Messiah are the "same people" that Jeremiah spoke about!

Heb. 12:22-24 - assembly of the firstborn! enters New Covenant. Heb. 11:1, Exod. 4:22-23! Israel is & was the firstborn assembly, of Heb. 12:22-24!
