A weight or load that God has given you to carry, until He comes along and accomplishes it. A constantly recurring idea or theme repeatedly personally given to a child of God, by God. A consuming passion for a cause or a purpose. No rest can or will be experienced until the divine unction comes to pass. It must be found in scripture. * Divine burdens are light. Matt 11:30

1) Every child of God, has or should have a divine burden. You will not and cannot accomplish anything for God, without one!

2) Burdens can and do change according to God's will and season.

3) Burdens that are divine can be shared with God or with other believers. Self invented burdens usually have to be carried alone. Gal 6:2

4) All divinely given burdens must result in souls being born again and disciplined. Biblical burdens that God has called you to carry, always results in Kingdom expansion. Distress can occur until the burden is brought to pass.

5) Divine burdens never are lifted until accomplished. ^{from} ~~is a~~ ~~is a~~ ~~is a~~ They stretch around. Divine burdens however cannot be sold or transferred.

Biblical Examples: O.T. prophets all carried divine burdens and could not rest until their mission was complete. These burdens would often result in books of the Bible being written. The Bible is a collection of burdens

Moses - Exodus 10:27 & 28 - Moses did not regard his own safety but continued to appear before Pharaoh because of a divine burden to deliver the Hebrew slaves. He could not cease ^{his ministry} even in danger's face.

Yeshua's - zeal and burden for the Father's will is what propelled and energized him in His earthly activity. John 2:16, Psalm 69:9. Isiah 9:7. His burden to be obedient to the plan of eternal life. Luke 12:50.
