Gehenna was the valley of garbage burning in Jerusalem's Valley of Hinnom and these flames of Gehenna will consume & annihilate the wicked in like manner ~~to~~ to that of burning garbage. Gen. 2:7 - Adam was not an immortal soul. He became "a living soul" through Yahweh's "neshamah" #5397.

Scripture teaches that human souls can die by rejecting Messiah. Lev. 23:30, Ezekiel 18:4, Josh 10:35.

in hell or the lake of fire. They will be covered just as they
were created. Life or death! Not life or life!

~~✱~~ ✱ The saved will have souls clothed or gifted with immortality
at the 1st resurrection before the millennium. This immortality is
gifted or bestowed by the only immortal one, to His children.
Rev. 20:6 is when we become or are made immortal.
