## Final Rehearsals

Yom Teruah is a dress annual rehearsal for the regathering of Israel at the return of Yahuah. The shofar will sound and all of redeemed Israel will rise out of their tombs. 1 Thess 4:14-18.

Those who are alive and are saved will be changed. Each Yom Teruah is a celebration or rehearsal for the "Mechayah Ha Metim" and "the change" from mortality to immortality. 1 Cor 15:49-52.

Phil 3:20-21. Dan. 12:2. This is the ultimate change! Rev. 20:4-6. The saved spirit reunites with a new glorified body Col. 2:16-17.

Shadows or dress rehearsals of "things to come". Moed "appointment for rehearsal". This annual rehearsal of the "mechayah ha metim" is called Yom Teruah not Rosh Hashanah. Lev. 23:24-25. Blowing trumpets is a reminder of things past & things to come! This moed is in the 7<sup>th</sup> month to remind us of the messianic resurrections of the dead that will take place at the dawn of the 7<sup>th</sup> yr of human history!

Num 29:1

Rosh Hashanah - means New Year. It is not New Year. It is the 1<sup>st</sup> day of month 7. 1 Kings 1:34 tells us it is a day to prepare to meet the king. Neither is it the day of creation since creation took place in eternity past before Yahuah made days. Gen 1:1-1:5. Neither is it a time of receiving forgiveness, since only Yahuah's blood gives that. Traditional Judaism asks for one more year, while Yahuah's book of life grants eternal not temporal life. Lev. 20:15.

Close. Yahuah tells us how to rehearse Numb. 10:1-10. For years one shofar was blown for Judaism. A lot of leaders showed up to mislead Israel. v. 4. But in these final rehearsals v. 3 both shofars or silver trumpets must rehearse blowing to prepare both houses to meet their Savior. When the people show up to be instructed by His presence at the place of meeting, division and classes flee. Both houses all Israel need to be more Teruah observant not more Jewish. The unified sound

of a people rejoicing will show Yahshua that we are ready to be a nation ready to be led by Him through Torah obedience. When we are finished rehearsing by

considering all in our midst "Israel," then V. 12 will come to pass. The camp will set out to join Yahshua through resurrection.

This will happen Num. 10-1, when he makes both horns silver <sup>or</sup> pure via beating & tribulation. Let us use the ten <sup>asker</sup> easier or rich days between now & Yom Kippur to make things right with our Israelik brothers & our Father.

In Mark 9:35 we are called to serve our brothers not lord it. Let the twin trumpets sound! Psalm 89:15 "Joyful triumph."
