Text 8-29-

"Glorification Thru Conformation"

"Two Ordinations"

One day soon we will lay down our temporary body, & inherit an incorruptable, eternal, undefiled body that will be a physically resurrected body. All believers have the same ultimate destiny. Our glorified body will have all the characteristics of Yeshua's glorified resurrected body. (1 John 3:2). We all will inherit this grand, overcoming event.

v29- Foreknow- God has sealed your future to be with Him. His omniscience knew you as ordained to eternal physical resurrection before you were born. (Jerm 1:5). Greek word is proginosce. It means to ordain you before you were made.

Once He ordained you, He then set out on a slow process, sometimes painful and aggravating, to eventually & gradually to be conformed to the image of His Son. Conformation has a dual purpose. ① For this life - Molding & shaping & sculpting us to look, walk, act, behave & talk like Yeshua. We are not what we used to be and we are not yet what ~~we~~ we will be. Every day is a day of progressive change. It has to be gradual or we would die on the operating table. We tried to change ourselves, but failed. God changes us more in 5 minutes, than we all have tried in our lifetime. (Phil 1:6) ^{v29} Since we are Yeshua's adopted brothers, & we are in His family & He is already glorified, the same destiny awaits us. Yeshua was the first to rise from the dead. We are next in line. He is the first to receive His prize. We're next.

v.30 ② ^{v.30} God's formula for ultimate glorification. (will happen)
Predestination + Calling = Justification + Physical Glorification.

In Greek - Predestination means ordained but limited. Ordained our salvation,

but put limits on our temporary body. The day is coming when God will take off these limitations & we'll be able to transcend time & space just like Yeshua, walking through doors.

Everyone who is predestined is called to the Priest-hood of believers. All born again believers have been called & placed into the ministry, due to their justification. Justification is the only requirement for a life of service to the Lord. Justification means just as if I've never sinned.
2 Cor 5:17-19.

U.30 - Is God confused? He uses a past tense. He tells us that we have already been glorified. Because He calls these things that are planned but have not yet come to pass, as having already happened. In God's purpose it has happened. We merely are waiting for the physical manifestation.

Romans 4:17 - Eph 2:16 We are Yeshua's brothers. His entire life was pre-planned & then he got his new physical body. Our entire life is pre-planned & our end will be the same as Yeshua's end. The end of verse 30 is a personal messianic prophecy for your ultimate destiny. (Daniel 12:12).

U.31 - Dayanau, to all these individual blessings. Rav Shaul is left speechless. He asks 7 questions designed to lift us up.

~~U.31~~ - Despite all earthly problems, we are to rejoice in our eventual physical adoption. No one can stand against God's design.

*** U.32-39 - Read. ***

Close - Since glorification is a factual foregone conclusion, U.32-39 are designed to teach us that God's ordination of physical resurrection will come to pass, just as his ordination of our salvation has come to pass.
