

Rev 3:7 - Isaiah 22:22 Have You Thanked God For Those Closed Doors Lately? (1)

It's like a key that works like no ordinary key. Many times it locks doors rather than opens them. One man Has David's Key! No one can open without David's Key. Only the Son of David can ~~open~~ ^{lock} a door of opportunity, finance, ministry, relationship or various other situations, which no locksmith in the world can open.

Illustrate - Have you ever been locked out of your car? You couldn't get in. You couldn't break in. You had no tools or no key. Only a master artist could open if he chose to. If a master locksmith or tow operator didn't let you in you couldn't have entered. Could that ~~have~~ ^{possibly} have been a blessing from Abanai? Sure. Maybe he kept you off the road to save you from physical harm in an impending auto accident. His omniscience saved you!

Good News - Elohim loves and tenderly cares for us, so much so that He locks doors that could easily wind up putting us at the wrong at the wrong time! Often times we are so busy begging Hashem to open doors ^{leading} to our eternal detriment, ~~when~~ when we should be praising and gleefully thanking Hashem for the Key of David shutting doors which if opened would lead to mirages of danger, fear, confusion, fruitlessness and death.

Praise YHWH for David's Key. In the natural David's Key seems to often be the wrong key, when it doesn't work. In the spirit ^{God} has often sovereignly designed it not to work. - Rev 22:7 - Tishua shuts, no man opens. Isaiah 22:22 - Messianic prophecy. The Father the master locksmith has given Tishua David's Key, before the foundation of the world. Isaiah 9:7 Job 12:14 - No release if imprisonment takes place by David's Key.

Examples of A Closed Biblical Door - Balaam in Numb. 23 - went to curse Israel. Since David's Key had ordained Israel to be blessed, YHWH met him and crushed his feet against the wall & made his donkey immobile unwilling to take Balaam to Israel's camp for a cursing session. Numb 23:32-34. Abanai closed that door and later through Balaam uttered the other side/prophecy of Messianic advents.
