  - 4) Choose not to fornicate or curse.
  - 5) <sup>Learn</sup> Choose to harness their appetites.
  - 6) Getting comfortable as a believer-priest.
  - 7) Realized they need a covering in a legal body. Their ~~liars~~ <sup>liars</sup> are learning to establish daily prayer patterns. In transition from takers to givers. No longer wear spiritual diapers.
  - 8) Beginning to produce spiritual children, & supporting them spiritually through discipleship.

Close - Have (past tense) overcome the devil, by strength. Use that stubborn strength to overcome the world. U.15.

Children - Victim to the devil, world & flesh.
