 1 Corinth 5:7-8 Purge - Clean out Chama 2 Cleavage from the dwelling place of HaShem. Today is the day of Bedekat Chama 2. The modern day term for purge is repent. ~~Repentance~~ ~~Shed~~

Repentance - 3 Types Outlined in Scripture Only one is true Bedekat Chama 2! Repentance preceded by <sup>search</sup> confession and followed by forsaking of sin.  
 Repentance - Te shuv - return. (Hebrew). Return to the correct way!  
 Metanoia - (Greek) Change your thinking. Reversal of my decision!

Pressure ~~Repentance~~ Ekka thairo - pruned yourself from within (used 2x in N.T.)  
 As believers we need to repent Biblically. The devil is happy to sell us a counterfeit, unbiblical repentance, in order to miss our mark.

Preparation to the Passover ~~Repentance~~ Do we repent Biblically? What kind of Bedekat Chama 2 are we doing as we ~~repent~~ Of Conviction ~~Exodus 9:27~~ Hail rained down. Pharaoh's repentance says the right thing. But it was a counterfeit. (U34). Pharaoh sinned more, hardened his heart again & came back to his original thinking & original behavior. It was convenient for Pharaoh to repent because he didn't like hail balls on his head or on his children's head. It was brought about by outward pressure. Much of our repentance, is caused in our lives by pressure. This kind of repentance is designed to relieve stress or pressure. Characterized by: 1. Lip service 2. Lack of agreement with the Lord.

3. Lack of a broken heart over his offence. Main Goal: Removal from pressure cooker.  
 \* Result of this kind of repentance - (U35) ~~U34~~ Rehardening of heart. That's not victory.  
~~Repentance~~ Day returns to his vomit. Not lasting!

Failure ~~Repentance~~ ~~Repentance~~ <sup>repentance</sup> Of Self Pity - Judas (Matt: 27:3-5) "I have sinned". Repentance brought about by failure & shame. Self pity. (U31). He sought comfort from the Pharisees (U31), & scribes because of his guilty conscience. He couldn't sleep or live with himself & he sought repentance & forgiveness to "relieve himself" of guilt. Someone love me please. He was motivated to repent by ~~failure~~ ~~failure~~ ~~failure~~ failure. ~~Repentance~~ He sought pity for himself from the world & found none. This world has no pity or mercy to give. Their lack of mercy sent him into a tailspin that led to suicide. ~~Had~~ this been a true act of repentance he wouldn't have gone to a priest but to God's son. Judas was the first man to seek forgiveness from a priest. He had no desire to get right with God. A merely religious act. He was sorry that his plans had failed that Yeshuy didn't overthrow Rome that he lost his power & position. Self pity brought about by failure.

3. ~~T'shuva~~ <sup>T'shuva</sup> Of Contriteness - Biblical. Acceptable To and before God. (Luke 15:17) Parable of Prodigal Son. Characterized by:

- 1. humility (U. 21) Not worthy. 2. broken heart (U. 17). over one's own sin & failures. Going to God not because of pressure, but because of a desire to make things right with a "loving father". 3. Directly seeking God for forgiveness. No detours. 4. Reversal of decisions & thinking. 5. A forsaking of all rebelliousness. 6. Getting into agreement leads to a close walk. Amos 3:3. Leads to full surrender to God leads to an

① Luke 19:8-9 Turn from old thinking & behavior to new one. This be'echat hametz fueled by love for Yeshua.

Close - It eliminates doublemindedness & Luke-warmness. - Only acceptable motive.

① "Against you & you alone have I sinned - Biblical repentance with a proper motive will eventually relieve inward pressure & outward pressure. The other 2 kinds will cause the pressure to return.

T'Shuva ~~Repentance~~ of Contriteness is "the first" step toward walking & staying in the Spirit. After this kind of ~~repentance~~, you are immediately & automatically in the Spirit. t'shuva
