

A Prophetic Call to all Biblical (lunar based) Shabbat Keepers With School Age Children

As more and more of Yisrael makes teshuvah-repentance and accepts the true solar-lunar calendar and the moon based weekly 7th day Shabbats, another snare lays covered from plain site. And unless we learn and take concrete steps right now to expose and destroy this snare, it will be used by s.a.tan to destroy both you and your precious children before Yahuwah.

The sad fact remains that most children of school age, even children of Torah keeping adults who also have discovered the truth of biblical Shabbat send their children outside the home for schooling. These children usually attend government Pharaoh schools, or Christian schools. Now both these options are part and parcel of the underlying snare, waiting to destroy both you and your testimony before YHWH. You have made a huge sacrifice to be free to worship on biblical Shabbat. Don't blow it now.

You see, in both the government school under Pharaoh and the Christian school under Kaiser, we have two systems that will allow your school age children to attend religious services in a Jewish church on Saturday, or a Christian church on Sunday. Your children are free to observe and honor both these days. The devil gives you that allowance, as these are his educational systems. He is the principal. That's the way the devil has it all set up. You see, s.a.tan knows the true Shabbat according to Torah is not tied to a pagan Roman week, or weekend, but rather to the 2 faithful heavenly time pieces, the sun and moon. He thus wages no wars to enslave your children in the classroom on Saturday or Sunday. He has allowed these 2 systems under his control to give limited religious freedom on these 2 Roman days, thinking that he still holds authority over the biblical Shabbat hidden in the skies in plain view. The devil takes great delight in freeing your children for weekend services (Sunday School and Talmud Torah), while ruling over the true Shabbat by attempting a deception that will cause families to be split and children to grow up callous towards the lunar commanded Shabbat. While the parents do their very best to observe 8,

15, 22 and 29, their children are away and the family is not in unity. This is s.a.tan mocking the Shema. Devarim-Deut 6:

4 Shema Yisrael: YHWH is our Elohim, YHWH is Echad:

5 And you shall love YHWH your Elohim with all your lev, and with all your being, and with all your might.

6 And these words, which I command you this day, shall be in your lev:

7 And you shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your bayit, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise up.

8 And you shall bind them for an ot upon your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.

9 And you shall write them upon the posts of your bayit, and on your gates.

The fourth commandment says this:

Shemot-Exodus 20:8 [Daled] *Remember Yom Ha-Shabbat, to shomer it as kadosh.*

9 *Six days shall you labor, and do all your work:*

10 ***But the seventh day is the Shabbat of YHWH your Elohim: in it you shall not do any work, you, nor your son, nor your daughter, your male eved, nor your female eved, nor your cattle, nor your ger that is within your gates:***

As you know by now, the biblical Shabbat while fixed in the heavens, floats on the pagan calendars' of men. So one month Shabbat can be Roman Tuesday and the next month Roman Wed. **Now this makes it virtually impossible for those whose children attend these systems to be free to honor biblical Shabbat as signaled and determined by the heavens alone.** Yet YHWH does not tell us 'don't worry about it, I understand.' We are to produce obedience, which is better than the sacrifice of endless excuses. YHWH already knows the predicament that you and your children are in. He understands the predicament and has empathy, but does not understand nor desires to understand the excuses, as He has made a way of escape for all SINCERE followers. See 1 Corinthians 10:13:

13 There has no trial come upon you but such as is common to all men: but YHWH is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted above that which you are able to bear; but will with the trial also make a way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

So if the truth be told and it is in this prophetic calling, all children in public school, or Christian school cannot observe biblical Shabbat, as the penalty for doing so is truancy, a fine, or jail time to the parents involved in such attempted Torah honoring activity. Any parent that takes a stand for their child to have biblical Shabbat off weekly (as it will fall on school days 7-8 months in a school year) will have to face severe penalties, with their children being victimized into the truancy classification and the parents prosecuted to the fullest extent of man's law.

If nothing else this shows us that s.a.tan only fights the knowledge and practice of the true biblical Shabbat and does not waste his time, or deceptive skills in forbidding Saturday or Sunday false Shabbats. Under these school systems, s.a.tan approves of Sunday and Saturday Shabbats, by freeing the children to be free on those days, while raising no opposition to them. **Even if you did not know one single verse of Scripture, or could not prove what day is Shabbat from Scripture, observing s.a.tan's behavior regarding our children, should tell you all you need to know. Remember what s.a.tan opposes is what is true and a threat to him.**

So those who have determined to observe biblical Shabbat have yet another dilemma to overcome. It is and was enough of a challenge to take off on your job without getting fired. But assuming you have already overcome that, your beloved children, now present the biggest opening for s.a.tan to destroy your testimony to live like Yisrael and serve YHWH in Ruach and emet-truth, if you allow them to be his pawns and remain unprotected by Torah. And if the truth be told, if you do not overcome this obstacle, you risk losing your children to the true Shabbat in their adult lives, along with the risk of losing your credibility with them and before YHWH.

When you allow your children to attend school on biblical Shabbat, even though you know better, what message are you in essence sending them and reinforcing in them every week? The message is this. School is more important than Shabbat, the fear of man is more motivating than the fear of Yahuwah and despite what I say with my mouth, obedience to YHWH is not as important to you as doing well in school and making sure you are seen and accepted as a fully compliant student for the world's beast system. Your economic well being and career is more important than inheriting the blessings found in the eternal things of Israel.

I share this NOT in condemnation, but in hope that plain and common sense truth will prevail, hoping you will do what YHWH requires of you.

For those parents who currently send their children off to school on biblical Shabbat knowing all these things, you have some serious choices to make. Deep down, these parents know that as soon as they send their children out the door, the children will be forced to break Shabbat, by forcing their teachers and other childcare givers to work and labor before them in a school setting. Moreover, when Johnny, or Jennie is given lunch money, or yearbook money, or some other mammon, there is buying and selling taking place, with your child as the active agent. This scenario before YHWH is unacceptable and abominable and YHWH is bringing this to your attention now, so that as Israel, you have the call and clarity not to think that He approves, or winks at this, but that He expects you to take corrective action to immediately correct this problem, while you can.

Fortunately we can overcome this challenge and trial, just like we overcame others by faith in Yahshua and by faith in His strength and courage in and through us. When I was raising my children, homeschooling was a nice option. Because when I kept the false Saturday as Shabbat, even if my children attended Christian school, or Jewish school, or public Pharaoh school, they were free to go to Jewish church, or Christian church on Roman weekends, as we all believed those days to be kosher. But now that we have been entrusted with the truth of the biblical Shabbat and we have our children in these school systems, we no longer have that choice. Those school systems are set up, as are the majority of western jobs, to enslave you, so that you do not have the flexibility that you need to serve YHWH, unhindered and unshackled. So while homeschooling was merely an option when I was parenting, it is a divine directive in this generation and in these last of the last days. Keep in mind that for Christians and Jews, homeschooling remains one possible option among many schooling options. But for the redeemed righteous remnant of Israel and the adult parents who already have made great sacrifices to obey YHWH in Shabbat guarding piety, unless you immediately and without prayer (why pray about the 4th commandment, for it is already written) place your children in a home school setting, you risk allowing the devil back into your lives to reverse your prior obedience before YHWH. Remember it's not how we start to run after hearing, but how and whether we even finish in obedience.

As much as you and I love our children as the dearest most precious possessions we have been entrusted with on earth, unless we use this admonition from the Rauch to make sure they are in submission to YHWH's call to YOU, we are in deep and immediate trouble. If you cannot, or will not act and change course, then the fear of man abides in you over and above the fear of YHWH. And as an apostle, knowing full well the frail, yet fallen human nature, most of Nazarene Yisrael today, will not shema-hear and obey to this admonition, even as our stiff-necked forefathers did not obey. And knowing ahead of time the rejection of this message, that does not release me from the burden to discharge it, in the hope that some in Yisrael will reverse course, since we are all so new to the biblical Shabbat and all the sacrifices that it entails.

What is at stake is your very obedience before YHWH and your testimony before your own children. Remember that if we don't change course, the message that is being reinforced is that going to school on biblical Shabbat is more important than resting on the correct Shabbat. And you can rest on the weekends' son; so don't worry. Just do good in school and do your homework. Then doing homework supersedes the 4th commandment in the impressionable minds of our youth! And who is ultimately responsible for this? We can continue to blame Pharaoh, or begin to look for that way of escape that Scripture promised us.

Remember semi-righteous Lot! He was such a politically correct compromiser, that though he held YHWH's truths dear, by refusing to live them out in front of his children, he lost

them all anyway via heaven's judgment. Later on, they decided to commit incest with a man they saw continually compromise on YHWH's calling! Lot was a parent who leaned on his own understanding and the fear of man and in the end became nothing more than a double minded clown, whom these girls desired to rape, as he had already lost all respect in their eyes.

I have told you the truth in love because YHWH said SPEAK. "This is your first message after your surgery" said He. Make sure that you do not make the messenger your enemy, because he has told you the uncomfortable truth in love, preparing you for the millennial kingdom and for your child's future way past their school years.

How you can please YHWH in the challenge-matter at hand:

-Begin to homeschool immediately trusting YHWH for the strength and provision so you and your children can obey YHWH together.

-If you "cannot" home school, find a home school group in your city that your child can join and pay/bless the teacher some, so that your children can still keep lunar Shabbats.

-Pay a teacher, or ask a friend to teach the children in your home while you work. At least this way they will be free to obey YHWH's days.

-Start a school in conjunction with your congregation's leadership that will allow the freedom to obey YHWH in 8, 15, 22 and 29 Shabbat keeping. Lead others by example. Be a living epistle to others!

-Find or plan on joining a community of believers living together in moshav-kibbutz-believing communities, so that both you and your children are free to 'come and go' by the Ruach as you please.
