What Would the Jews Do or What Would Yahshua Do?

***WHY WE WILL NOT BE CELEBRATING ROSH HASHANNA THIS WEEK AND WHY WE ARE A "MONTH BEHIND!"***

Some people new to our 26 years of service to YHWH may be puzzled by the fact that we as Jewish and Efraimite believers do not and will not celebrate "Rosh Hashana" later this week on Sept 9-10th. This is for 2 reasons friends. I will make this simple for you.

Reason #1-The Jewish calendar calls the Feast of Trumpets Rosh Hashanah-New or Head of the Year, with an overriding theme of forgiveness of sins. However the actual first month of the year is the spring month of Passover. See Exodus 12:1-3 and Deuteronomy 16:1. We are commanded to guard/ observe/mark that month/moon as the correct New Year. Yom Teruah has no connection whatsoever to sins forgiven or New Years Day; if you want to follow Jewish tradition if it makes you feel better, or more Hebraic, go ahead, but count me out. Leviticus 23:24-25 gives us the true reason for Yom Teruah. A memorial assembly to remember. Remember what? Creation, Torah and the Master's coming at the end of the age. PERIOD. Nothing about forgiveness or New Year!

Reason # 2-In the times of the Second Temple and before the leaders/priests knew that Aviv today called Nissan, the first moon of the year, could not start in winter as it was the month that commenced Spring. In other words, Aviv 1 must begin in Spring not winter.

Since Spring was usually around March 21st the biblical turn of the year when the sun's shadow would be due west-east as it shone through the Eastern Gate in Jerusalem, all Aviv ones' would begin as the first new moon day-Rosh Chodesh after the "turn of the year." So say the direct parallel west-east shadow of the late afternoon sun occurred and the next new moon was 6 days later, 6 days later was Aviv 1. However the rabbis changed that!

**With the destruction of the Temple and Cohanim/priests being replaced by the rabbis and their comical Jewish calendar, they changed the Word of YHWH. Under their supervision, Aviv 1 no longer had to start after the "turn of the year." Only Passover, day 14 of Aviv, had to be after the "turn of the year." That meant that in some years, they would knowingly and willfully start AVIV/NISSAN 1 BEFORE the "turn of the year," meaning they started Spring in the Winter, as long as the "turn of the year" was before PASSOVER.**

So to repeat. Aviv 1 every single year must be after the "turn of the year." The rabbis said no. Only Passover must be after the "turn of the year" and Spring/Aviv 1 can start in Winter as long as Passover Aviv 14 was in Spring.

That's why today we have this mess. So we have cleaned it up and that's why now we are in month 5 not 6 and why the fall feasts are not until Roman October. Last year the greatly anticipated Aviv 1 was delayed a month because the "turn of the year" had not occurred. Thus the heavens (not the Israeli or Egyptian barley which does not work anywhere but Israel sometimes) told us that in order to start the year in Spring and keep the feasts in the Spring, we had to add a month, making last year a biblical 13th month "leap year." That's why

we are a FULL month behind the Jewish calendar and thankful to YHWH for it!

I hope that explains why you should not celebrate the FALL FEASTS this week in the Summer before the "autumnal turn of the year!" The autumnal turn of the year occurs Sept. 21, or around there and thus the FALL FEASTS cannot begin in Summer. The reason they and most of you are a month early is because most of you follow the Jews, without having a clue to what they are up to and have failed to add a 13th month last year, when the heavens demanded it. That's why we strongly encourage you all to do it right and celebrate Sukkoth with us at the correct time or join us on the radio. For more help please see:

Final Point-The Jewish calendar knows that they have to add a 13th month every 3 years, or so, to reconcile the 11 day difference between the annual lunar and solar cycles. But because they have divorced themselves from observing the heavens annually (every Shabbat and also) every Aviv and they go by a pre-calculated Hillel calendar where they have arbitrarily added 7 "13 month leap years" every 19 years regardless of what the heavens say, they live in ongoing error. While this does keep the feasts in season, it adds a 13 month in years when the heavens do not declare that such is needed and fails to add a 13th month like last year, when the heavens demanded it. That's why the HEAVENS ALONE must determine all moeds, with the 7th day Shabbat being the first one listed in Leviticus 23, so mankind cannot continue to manhandle YHWH's days. You owe it to yourself

to get this understanding, because if you don't, YHWH's APPOINTED times will fail you as you unknowingly favor religion over the heaven's 2 faithful witnesses.
